RECENT SURVEY RESULTS

It was agreed at the Residents' General Meeting on the 6^{th.} June that an **Exit Gate Survey** would be conducted, to ascertain whether Residents wished to retain the Swipe Card Exit System or not. **The results were verified by Carolynne Young.** The results are as follows:-

Retain the Swipe Card Exit System - YES - 89 NO - 41

Possible Number of Voting Residences = 158

Number of Informal Votes = 1

Number of No Responses = 27

Percentage Voting - YES = 67.9%

Percentage Voting - NO = 31.3%

Working on the usual democratic processes that the majority rules in such voting situations, the current Swipe Card Exit System will be retained.

WINTER FIRE SAFETY!!!

It is the time when you want to be warm, but real care should be taken during the winter months with electric heaters, electric blankets etc. Here are some "Helpful Hints":-

*** Check electric cords and plugs for wear.

*** **Do not** overload power points or power boards, with too many appliances.

Do not leave your electric blanket on for too lengthy a time. Do not forget to turn it off.

*** **Do not** place clothes over or too near electric bar heaters.

*** Be careful with electric clothes dryers. Clean the lint filter regularly!

EMERGENCY CALL SYSTEM

If Residents have an emergency of any description in their homes, they should not hesitate in pressing the **Emergency Call Button.** It is far better to have a "False Alarm", rather than being too slow, because Residents are trying to telephone **600 or 762**, after Office Hours. The **Emergency Call System** is an important feature of our Village and is monitored **24 hours per day.** The system is there to be used and Residents are urged to use it, whenever they believe it is necessary!
