APPROVED PURCHASES

At the Residents' General Meeting on the 6th. June, approval was granted for two major purchases for the Village. It is important to provide an update on these purchases for all Residents and to advise that your Committee has been most businesslike in pursuing very competitive prices for both the Commercial Dishwasher and the Public Address System.

We researched the market for suitable Commercial Dishwashers, with tremendous assistance being provided by Ian Jurgs. We eventually selected a Norris BT500 Dishwasher, which has 1, 2 and 5 Minute Cycles. We paid \$3,700.00 for the Dishwasher plus \$64.00 for two (2) extra Dishwasher Racks. The Meeting actually approved \$6,000.00 plus Installation. Therefore, we achieved a great result, which was way under the approved Budget! The Dishwasher has been delivered to the Village and the Installation is currently being negotiated with Lifestyle SA.

The Public Address System, was also researched very carefully and was trialled, as was suggested at the Residents' General Meeting, in our own Community Centre Hall before purchase. We paid \$2,380.00, which was \$600.00 cheaper than a Resident's Probus Club paid two years ago! Your Committee has been very responsible, in its management of these major purchases!
