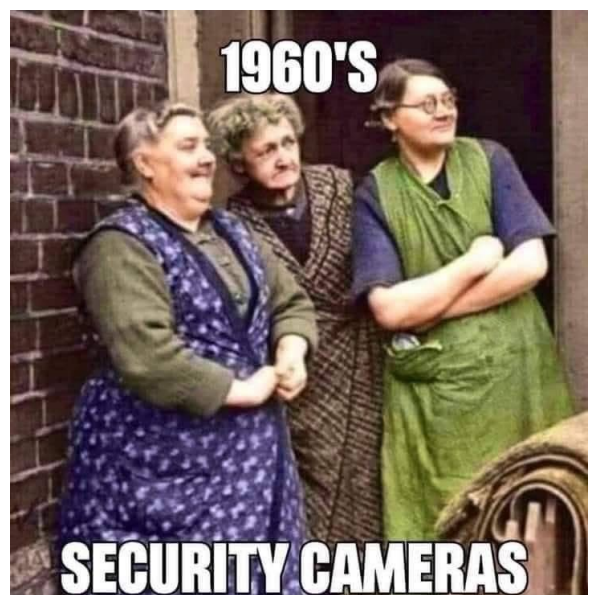

person did not know what I was talking about.

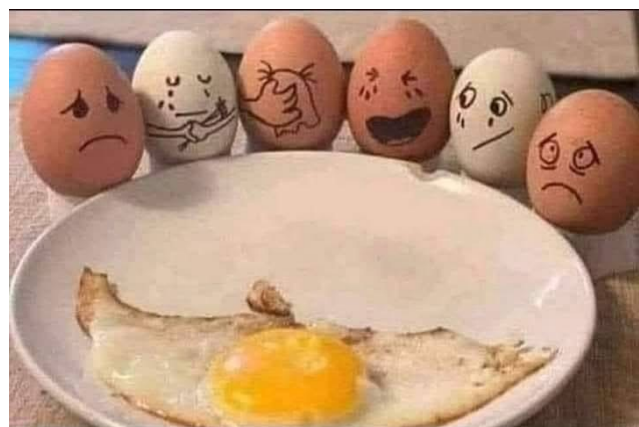

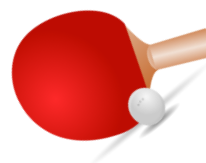
