I am working closely with the Liquor and Gambling Commissioner; Stephen Norris from Lifestyle SA and Lifestyle SA's Lawyers, re progressing our Liquor Licence Application. We are really breaking new ground as Lifestyle SA's first Village to apply for a Liquor Licence and also with the Commissioner, as I am led to believe that we are the first Retirement Village in South Australia to seek a Liquor Licence. The process is complicated and very thorough and there certainly are issues to be addressed. I am very confident that we shall be successful, but it may take more time than we were initially advised.

"Happy Hours" will continue to operate as BYO alcohol, until the Liquor Licence is approved. Soft drinks are available, as normal from the Bar.
